RESOLUTION ADOPTED AT THE 13TH ALL INDIA CONFERENCE OF THE MINISTERIAL STAFF ASSOCIATION, SURVEY OF INDIA HELD IN BANGALORE ON 10TH & 11TH SEPTEMBER, 2014 AT THE COMMUNITY HALL, BANGALORE

This All India Conference notes with a grave concern that despite as many as 4 important letters and a couple of Resolutions adopted unanimously in Kolkata All India Conference held on 10th, 11th & 12th January, 2012 and also in Bhubaneswar Central Executive Committee Meeting held on 23rd and 24th January, 2013 expressing concern over the moves of the-then Hon'ble Secretary to Government of India, Ministry/ Department of Science & Technology to his one-sided planning for Merger of Survey of India and NATMO and making/contemplating the new shape or formation into autonomous Body i.e, Corporation in the created alibi or pretext of "Re-designing and Neo-Modernization of Survey of India--Some plausible directions" both the Administrations viz., D S & T on one hand while S.G. on the other have been keeping complete and dubious silent over the issue right from December, 2011 upto this mid-September, 2014.

This All India Conference reminds the present Hon'ble Secretary & Joint Secretary (Admn.) of D S & T on one hand and the Surveyor General of India on the other, for their kind ready reference, of the detailed contents of the first two important letters on the subject issue as mentioned hereunder :-





This All India Conference re-iterates that the Staff Side of M.S.A., Survey of India is deadly against any such ill-directed move for Merger of Survey of India & NATNO and, thereafter, conversion of newly-modelled shape or formation into Autonomous Body (meaning Corporation) thereby inviting and/or indulging in Massive Outsourcing/ Contractorization/Privatization of Jobs coupled with further drastic cut or Reduction in Staff strength/Abolition of Offices/Abolition of Promotional Posts and other things giving rise to a lot of uncertainties-cum-mental anguish and holds that all such unilateral things do hardly come within the ambit of statutory powers or competencies of the DS & T.



The 13th All India Conference discusses from various angles over the entire issues in details and vehemently protests any such move or step for MERGER & AUTOMATION (CORPORATIZATION) and urges upon the appropriate authorities not at all to proceed further towards their purely one-sided direction for such dangerous moves to help restore normalcy and smooth functionings in this age-old traditional Union Government Department like Survey of India. The Conference further requests the DS& T and S.G. to intimate the Association as to exactly what is going to take place in this regard in near future.
