### **RESOLUTION NO. 1**

**Resolution adopted at the Central Executive Committee Meeting of Ministerial Staff Association, Survey of India held at Ranchi during 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2016.**

---

This Central Executive Committee Meeting expresses its deep anguish and extreme frustration as a result of the series of abortive actions as have so far been taken by the Departmental and Governmental Authorities for implementation of Cadre Restructuring in Survey of India in respect of Groups 'B' & 'C' Employees in general and Ministerial Staff in particular since last 12 years.

This CEC meeting and the entire Delegates attending the same from different parts of the country expresses its utter displeasure coupled with a degree of frustration over such inordinate and irresponsible delay in favourably settling this sensitive/ burning issue despite lapse of as many as 12 years which stands deplorable. This meeting, therefore, unanimously resolves that the issue of Cadre Restructuring be implemented maximum within two months from this date (i.e., before 31-07-2016) for which the Authorities at Dehra Dun and Delhi must leave no stone unturned for implementing the same by that period as, otherwise, it will be difficult to contain the simmering discontent amongst the Cadres thereafter meaning that the disappointed Ministerial Cadre as a whole are likely to break into appropriate agitational means causing dislocation to the smooth functioning in offices, the risk and responsibilities for which will squarely devolve on the shoulders of the Administrations at respective levels.

Further, the CEC Meeting in one voice strongly protests against the modified proposals of the Surveyor General of India submitted to DST on 18-03-2016 wherein the strength of Assistant has been reduced from the existing number of 286 to only 251 thereby onesidedly decreasing 35 posts of Assistant which has neither any logic nor ethics. Also the decision runs contrary to our peaceful official discussion held with the Surveyor General of India on 28-09-2015 wherein the MSA (CHQs) had raised strong objections in this regard and reasonably demanded altogether 310 posts of Assistants for barest minimum functional needs.
