SUB :- IMMEDIATE IMPLEMENTATION FROM BACK DATE/DUE DATE i.e. RETROSPECTIVE EFFECT OF THE QUITE UNNECESSARILY LONG – PENDING CADRE RESTRUCTURING – URGE FOR.

Sir,

Respectfully I like to draw kind attentions of Yourself and other D.S.T. Officials to the contents of the aboverferred letters on the captioned subject which were detailed and self-explanatory ones in all respects.

2. It is relevant and, as such, once again recapitulated that under para 7 of my detailed letter both for You & S.G. vide reference (v) above I had most reasonably claimed our minimum cadre-based ministerial posts depending exclusively upon the functional needs coupled with varied nature of jobs. Our demands were/are contained obviously in the posts meant for Sr. E&AO, Asstt. Director (O.L), E&AO, O.S, Assistant, Sr. HT, Junior HT, UDC & LDC to be distributed and/or catered in HQs at SGO and as many as 8 Zonal Offices, 8 Specialised Directorates, 24 GDCs & 4 Printing Groups. Needless to mention that these Offices are scattered at length and breadth of the Country.

3. With the delayed release of the Final Cadre Restructuring Proposals since submitted to DST from SG's and, in so far as the question of Ministerial Wing or portion thereof is concerned, the clear picture has now been exhibited. I don't say that a big mountain has, at length, given birth of a small mouse with SG's proposals/recommendations submitted to you ; on the contrary, let me say that ' something done though not many things or every thing'. My practical observations as well as considered evaluations on the entire things are enumerated as under for your active review/reconsiderations :-

(a) No date of effect for implementation of the quite longpending C.R. has been recommended/proposed by SG , albeit we have been demanding the same from back date (from December,2003 onwards) i.e. from the date on which the 2nd Cadre Review in r/o Sr. Gp. 'A' Officials raising the number of the-then existing Directors from 18/20 to 65 had been given effect to and implemented.

(b) SG should or might have easily requested / suggested that on immediate completion of the already- ongoing process work the long-overdue C.R. should, in no time, be implemented at DST-level itself as had been done in DEC,2003 at the time of Dr. P. Nag & in Feby, 2008 at the time of Major Genl. R.S. Tanwar. Not only this, many other cases/issues in general and the Grant of ACPs involving thousands of employees as also huge amount of expenditure (which might exceed crores of rupees) were got easily settled at DST-level itself when all those things were not required to be sent to Min. of Finance, Deptt. of Expenditure/DOPT.

(c) The post of Map Curator in Kolkata (Ministerial Post) has been stated to be kept as 'personal' by SG which is not accepted by us. M.C's post should, therefore, be retained as usual even after the present incumbent retires.
