## SURVEY OF INDIA

### RESOLUTION ADOPTED AT THE 13<sup>TH</sup> ALL INDIA CONFERENCE OF THE MINISTERIAL STAFF ASSOCIATION, SURVEY OF INDIA HELD IN BANGALORE ON 10<sup>TH</sup> & 11<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER, 2014 AT THE COMMUNITY HALL, BANGALORE

This All India Conference notes with a grave concern that the pretty long-overdue Cadre Restructuring is yet to be implemented despite repeated reminders/resolutions/faxes, etc. submitted from the end of the Association during last so many years as also despite repeated assurances given from time to time by the DS & T for early implementation. As an obvious result of this abnormal and inordinate delay in implementation of the Cadre Restructuring the Ministerial Staff-members as also the branches have been suffering from total disappointment and this Conference does not find any comprehensible reason for such delay.

This All India Conference comes to know that the DS& T, while finally approving the Cadre Restructuring proposals for Group 'A' Cadres, have decided to set up some expert committee to look into the affairs of C.R. in respect of Groups "B" & "C" meaning that the implementation of C.R. is going to be further delayed. The A.I.C. strongly objects to such move for formation of any further expert Committee and demands immediate finalization of the C.R. Proposals with modifications thereof already desired by the Association and implementation of the same right at DS&T- level itself keeping in view the reasonable sentiments expressed by the Delegates of the A.I.C. coming from length and breadth of the Country on one hand and the entire House on the other. The A.I.C. reminds the Departmental & Governmental Administrations that any further delay in implementing the long-pending C.R. will be seriously viewed by the Association and, unfortunately, some appropriate Organisational Trade Union/Legal steps/moves will have to be adopted to get the things done from the reluctant hands of the Higher-ups.


This A.I.C., while demanding implementation of the C.R. maximum by the end of this year (December, 2014), simultaneously urges upon DS&T and S.G. for immediate withdrawal of the Technical Officers viz., Superintending Surveyors/Officer Surveyors/Asst. Stores Officers/Asstt. Managers from Ministerial jobs being attended to at various offices of Survey of India for years together which should not at all be done in the fitness of things. It is more specifically observed by this A.I.C. that while attending DDO's jobs, the technical activities of the Department which these Technical Officers are meant for having undergone various costly training courses of the Govt., are being debarred from their regular allotted Technical jobs causing hindrance to the functioning of Government's Jobs. Side by side the chances of promotions from senior Office Superintendents to E & AOs are getting seriously marred for no apparent reasons, whatsoever.




