### SECRETARY GENERAL'S REPORT FOR SUBMISSION AT THE DELEGATES' SESSION OF THE CENTRAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING HELD AT RANCHI ON 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> JUNE, 2016

Dear Comrade Delegates,

My heartily welcome to all the Delegates attending this long awaited meeting at Ranchi, the Comrade city. Last All India Conference of our Ministerial Staff Association was held in Bangalore in the month of Sept. 2014. Due to ill-health of Comrade Manoj Sharma, I was given responsibility of Secretary General of Ministerial Staff Association by the august House. With the help of experienced and valuable suggestions of Com. T. D. Banerajee, Com. Sujit Sinha, Com. Manoj Sharma as well as of our CHQ's leadership & general members of branches, I could perform my duties with my best efforts to run our Association smoothly.

Policy of Central Government is-not favourable of labour class people. Farmers are adopting the suicides under liability of repaying heavy loans and anti-labour policy. Govt. is providing good platform for businessmen like Ambani & Adani. Friends ! as you all know well, in the present scenario, Central Govt. as well as our department, both are convergent upon Anti-Association/Union policy. Their first motto, is to how to demoralize the executive body members of Association/Union. We all know that the position of our Departmental Head does not appear to be so sound as he (the SG) can be able to solve each and every basic problems of ours but he can easily take up and/or forward all important policy matters to D.S.T. for early necessary action.

The NJFA/Confederation, have played huge role to the mobilization of employees and worker against the Seventh Pay Commission's anti-employees Report. Under the umbrella of NJFA all the Associations/Unions of Survey of India, CoC of UK, Railway unions & all India Defence employees Union are jointly taking part in the various movements at Uttarakhand time-to time. We also participated in the MARCH TO PARLIAMENT programme, called by NJFA at New Delhi on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2015, in support of 16 CHARTER OF DEMANDS of Central Govt. employees.

Our department is also facing so many problems during the running days. Downsizing and abolishing of the vacant posts, encouraging outsourcing of different services, is not a good sign for department's health. All the Service Associations/Unions of Survey of India are opposing and protesting these unhealthy matters. Frequently changes in the office of the Surveyor General of India, is also a great problem for us.

Since long, our Departmental Council Member Com. T. D. Banerjee, has been taking pains to settle down the burning issues of Ministerial Staff. Implementation of Cadre Restructuring is not settled as yet. Meeting of the COBs of MSA was held at SGO on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2015, with the former Surveyor General of India, on the issue of Cadre Restructuring, completion of pending DPCs, earliest withdrawals of Technical Officers from Ministerial Jobs, enhancement of Grade Pay of Ministerial Cadres, merger of SOI with NATMO And Change the nomenclature of the various posts of Ministerial Cadre, under the leadership of Comrade T. D. Banerjee. This meeting with the Survey of India administrative authorities was concluded in a healthy atmosphere and also showed some fruitful hopes for our cadre.

Comrades, with due consent of all the CoBs, I alongwith the CHQs/Branch leaders at Dehra Dun stations also attended the meetings convened by the Steering Committee MACP on Promotional Hierarchy, under the leadership of Com T.K.R. Pillai, Secretary General of All India Ministerial Staff Association, at New Delhi. On behalf of the MSA, Survey of India, we have assured our full agitational/financial support to settle down the long pending issue of MACP on Promotional Hierarchy, in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.


